Presentation of Work



This document outlines how children's work is to be presented.

- All work in all subjects must be dated, including maths workbooks.
- Work in exercise books must be dated by the children or an adult - short date (DD/MM/YYYY) in maths and foundation subjects and long date in English and R.E. (4th September 2017)
- The date should be written next to the margin and underlined.
- The WALT must be recorded in all subjects and should be written on the line underneath the date, beginning at the margin and underlined. It should be recorded in this format:

WE USE WALT AND WALA

- There should be no gaps in books so there is no need to start a new page for a new piece of work.
- All maths work should be completed in pencil.
- All diagrams should be completed in pencil, using a ruler for straight lines.
- Children from Year 5 may be introduced to using pen for writing if their handwriting is consistent, joined and legible.
- Children can use a purple pen to edit their work in any subject, including maths.
- Any errors made must be either rubbed out or one line drawn through the error.
